

THE CHARTER OF THE NEW YORK CONSPIRACY

MATICLE III Ranks

The Conspiracy shall consist of members of various ranks, each rank having particular requirements rights and responsibilities. The ranks are:

Conspiratore: [Each conspiratore shall have] 1/2, vote; any person within the Region may become a Conspirator by informing the Membership Secretary of his desire to do so; [a Conspirator] receives a conspiracy name from the Factorum D Lingua Conspiratoria Novum Eboracum (Nomenclature.)

Pupper: x 1 vote; appointed by a Director; recieves puppethood in Order o his appointer.

Secondary Directore: [such a Director has] 2 votes: [he] must have been a Conspirator who is nominated and then elected Secondary Director by a major vote of the Conspiracy; [he] recieves a Coat of Arms from the Chief of the Moraldde College and becomes Master of an Order (which he must name); can appoint 1 puppet; May also attain rank by purge.

Spacial Director: has 3 votes. Must be nominated and then elected Special Dispetor by 2/3's vote of the Primary Directors; recieves, if not previously a Sacondary Directora accoat of Arms and an Order. Can appoint 2 puppets. ing also attain renk by purge.

Primary Director: 5 votes. Must either by a Conspirator or Director who is proposed by I2 or more votes and is then elected by a majority of the primary Driectors. Recheves, if not previously a Secondary or Special Director, a Coat of Arms and becomes Master of an Order; can appoint 3 puppets. May also attain rank by purge.

A Momoger shall be considered to be nominated [for some rank] when a statemontonominating him shall have been printed in a newsletter.

ARTICLE, III Titaes ? Orders, and Offices and ...

In addition to a Conspiracy name, maembers of the Conspiracy will recieve violes, orders and offices.

When one is elected as Director for the first time, one may give oneself titles any others must be awarded by a a majority vote of the Conspiracy. When one accepts a puppethood, one recieves membership in the Order of Princery by see fact.

When one has a title, one may be awarded offices by a 2/3 vote of the Conspiracy.

Certain restrictions are placed upon the possesion of Primary Offices. No person may hold more than one Primary Office Only Primary Directors may hold Primary Offices.

ARTICLE IV Newsletters

[Note: This last sentence differs from a sentence in the same place in the Charter as printed by Ben Grossman. Since that printing of the Charter the Charter has been amended by a 15-0 vote to read as above.]

ARTIVLE V Vote Recorder's Newsletter

ARTICLE VI Purges

At any time a supper may purge his appointer. To do so, the purport must arrange to have notice of the purge published in a newsletter by a Director A Vote of Confidence among all Directors of the same rank as the appointer automatically thereby called for.

At any time, except when a purge is pending against him [by the puppet in question dammit] a Director may remove one or more of his puppets and if he wishes, offer the puppethoods to someone also, by telling the Member-ship Secretary and the Person offered puppethood, if any.

A Vote of Confidence shall consist of all Directors of the same rank as to Director being purged, except the Director being purged being able to vote as to whether or not he shall retain in his rank [SO WHAT THE HELL IS THAT SUPPOSED TO MEAN?] Unless a majority have confidence, then the purge fails [WHAT? Grossman, what you have just said is that if the majority does NO have confidence in the purgee, the purge fails. What you MEAN is exactly the opposite; if the majority DO have confidence, the purge fails.]

If a purge succedes, the purgins puppet is elevated to the rank hald by appointer, and receives any offices the appointer may have held. The appointer is reduced one rank (from Primary Director to Secondary Director, and from Secondary Director to Conspirator.)

If, within the vote deadline for the Vote of Confidence for a purge, the Vote Recorder recieves written notice from the puppet that he, the puppet no longer desires to donduct a purge, the purge shall be considered to have been denied. The results of a denied purge shall be wanted the same as the results of a failed purge, although the Vote Recorder must print notice that it was denied.

ARTICLE VII Resignation and Refusal

The Conspiracy is a participation-ordented organization. Therefore, at any time any and all offices, ranks, and puppethoods may be either resigned ore refused. If one resigns from a Directorship, one becomes a Conspiratore. If one resigns from Conspiratorship, one is removed from all aspects of the Conspiracy, and lose all things one may have recieved from the Conspiracy.

ARTICLE VIII Region.

All members of the Conspiracy, except Special Directors, must reside within the states of Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York, Conneticut, Rhode Island, Massachusetts, New Hampshure, Vermont or Maine for some part of the year.

ARTICLE IX Resolutions and Motions

Any Resolution or Motion proposed in a newsletter shall be adopted and passed it recieves a majority vote of all members.

ARTICLE X Voting

All votes must be mental to the Vote Recorder to be valid.

For purposes of the Charter, a majority vote shall consist of more than half of the legitimate votes cast; a 2/3's vote shall consist of more than 2/3 of the votest. [What about 3/4 votes?]

ARTICLE XI Amendments

This charter may be amended only by a vote of 3/4 of those eligible to vote. Actually what he means is that the Charter can be amended only by a 3/4 of those votes cast; Thus, a primary Director casts 5 votes while a Conspirator casts 1/2, and so on.]

Article XII Primary Offices

The following Primary Offices are hereby established and assigned to the named individuals until such time as they choose to resigne them [or, assumedly, propurged]

MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY Shall be in charge of all matters of names, titles, ranks, offices and whatnot that is included in the membership list. The membership list is available for an SASE. This office and a Primary Directorship are assigned to Ben Grossman.

serving at least 4 months.


